HOW TO BOOK A PERFORMANCE

STEP ONE: CONTACT US

Please prepare the following information: school's name and address, the grade attending, teacher's name, email and telephone contact, as well as the estimated number of students and chaperones.

STEP TWO: DEPOSIT DUE

A 50% non-refundable order deposit is due 10 business days after the date of your initial booking.

Please note, if strike action occurs on a show date that you have booked we will provide a full refund.

STEP THREE: FINAL STUDENT NUMBERS DUE

30 days prior to your ImPACt performance, we will contact you to confirm final numbers of students and chaperones, as well as any accessibility requirements. At this time, we will update the final order invoice and provide it to the school for final payment.

STEP FOUR: FINAL PAYMENT DUE

Final payment must be made before the ImPACt performance you are attending. Box office accepts payments of Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Interac, Cash or Cheque. Cheques can be made out to FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre and sent to FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre, 250 St. Paul Street, St. Catharines, ON, Canada, L2R 3M2. Once final payment has been processed a refund is not available.

IMPACT TICKETS

- Student general admission tickets for imPACt school performances are \$10^{+HST} per student.
- We provide 1 free ticket for every 10 students in JK to Grade 3.
- We provide 1 free ticket for every 20 students in Grade 4 to Grade 12.
- Please let us know ahead of time if accessibility accommodations are required.
